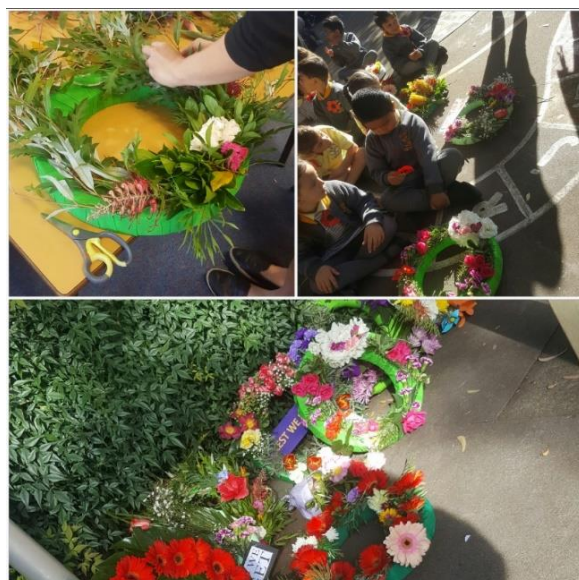
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Great to see the Gold Award winners coming through. Remember to save the Louie awards carefully and bring them in after you have 5.

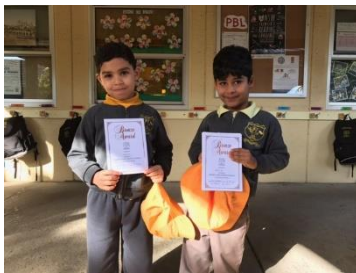

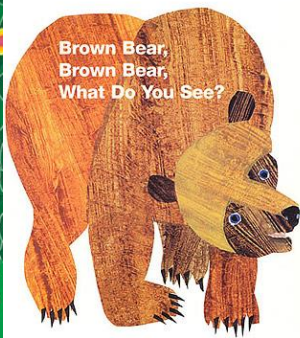


This week we have KB as the class to share some of their news and this display in the foyer.

In K Blue we have enjoyed reading a variety of texts about different animals.

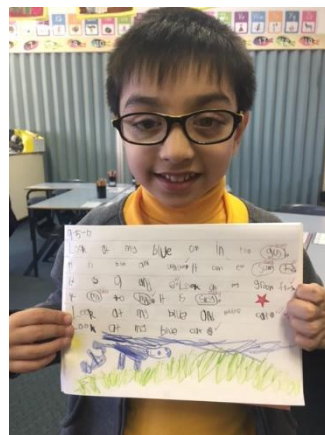
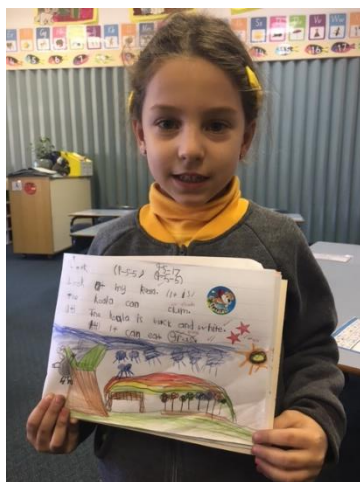
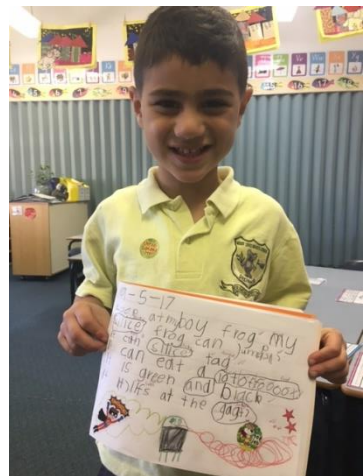
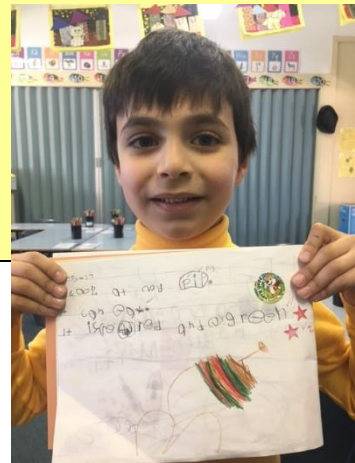
