Great to see the Gold Award winners coming through. Remember to save the Louie awards carefully and bring them in after you have 5.

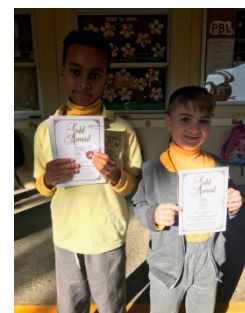

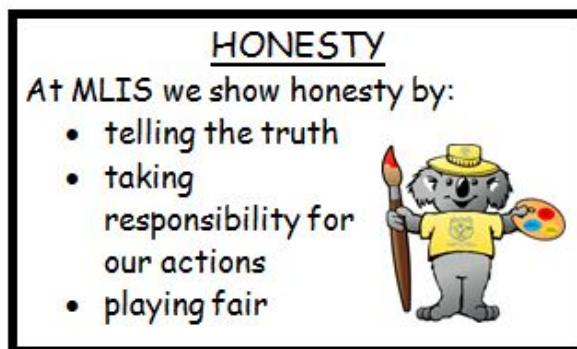

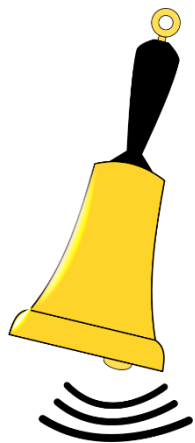
MORE STUDENTS, MORE ACTIVE, MORE OFTEN
