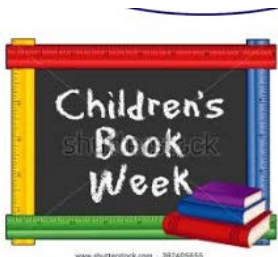

Looking forward to the 'Book Character Parade' tomorrow morning. If you are free please stay on after the bell to watch the character parade and then attend the Book Fair in the library.

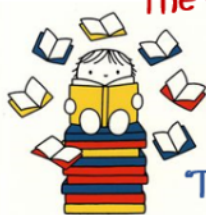
The Book Fair is also open for parents from 2:30pm today if you have time,

**Cost:** \$1.00 entry and an extra \$2.00 for popcorn and a drink.

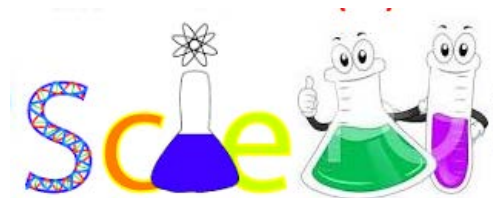
