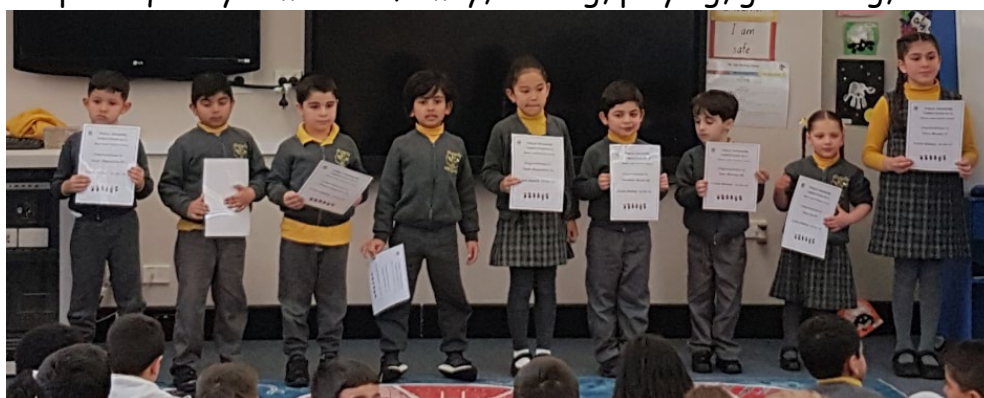

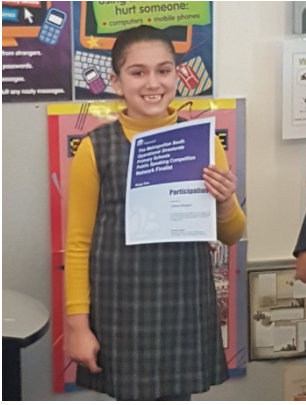
you all back in term 4, refreshed and ready to finish the year on a positive note.

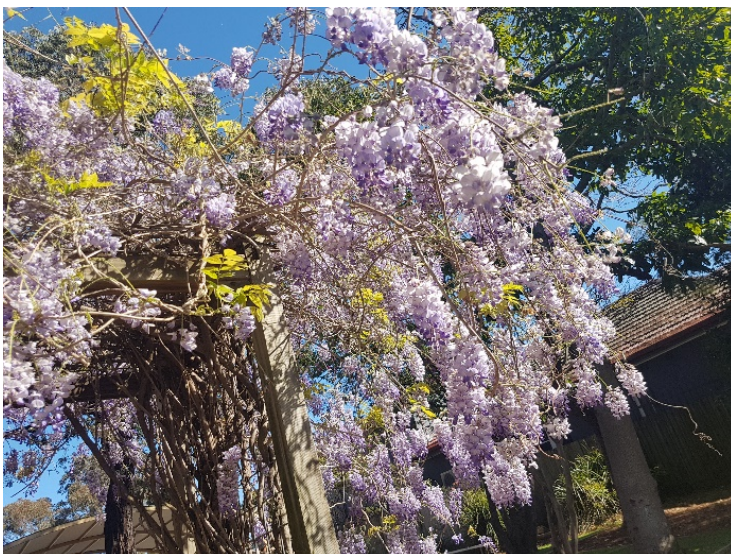


applied for the job and was successful at interview.
