Exciting Music Program for Term 2!



We all know how much children enjoy music. They are happy when they can make music using instruments and they enjoy learning through singing. For these reasons and many more, we are offering 'Jellybeans Music', as part of our program to enrich students' experiences

and offer specialist teaching through Mrs Karen Harcombe. Mrs Harcombe will be teaching music to our students for 10 weeks on a Thursday & Friday in Term 2.



The cost of the program will be **\$40 for the term**. That's just **\$4 per week** for a music lesson with a qualified music teacher.

UNIFORMS

Winter Uniforms for Terms 2 & 3:

Term 2 has started. In Terms 2 and 3, all students wear the winter uniform. Please see the display in the office area or speak to Mrs Markland or Mrs Conte for advice.



The school sells most of the uniform except the gold skivvy or gold long sleeve polo and grey stockings. Most parents buy the skivvy/polo from Target, Kmart, Big W, Lowes etc.

Girls: Grey Check Tunic/Dress with gold skivvy or gold polo and grey stockings.

Boys: Long Grey School Pants with gold skivvy or gold polo.

Everyone wears the grey zip jacket with school logo.

*Please note-girls who wear leggings must wear the plain, grey style.

It is important to wear the correct uniform, especially with the additional items like, stockings and hijabs. **Plain grey** is the correct colour. The school has a supply of leggings, hijabs and skivvies for the families who choose to purchase them.


GOLD SKIVV

GOLD L/S POLO






PBL NEWS & THIS WEEK'S SCHOOL VALUE


