Staff had prepared very informative and helpful presentations that gave families insight into how classrooms operate and gave you a feel for your child's classroom environment. This year a group photo was displayed of the support team (below) to let you know who works with your child other than the class teacher. Apart from the librarian, the community language and RFF teachers, all other support staff have a particular role that targets English or providing assistance with learning needs. We are very proud of the



additional assistance we provide all students and staff. More individual and group work is



achievable with more staff. Feel free to ask to meet the teachers who work with your children. They are often very loved by students as they provide targeted assistance and greater access to the curriculum. In the last week of term you will be able to have a meeting with your child's class teacher regarding learning and progress.

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# General Information/Useful Tips:

- 2. If your child is late in the morning, you must come to the office for a late note. Teachers will ask you for one as rolls are marked within the first 5min

- 5. If you need to make an appointment with a staff member, including myself, please call the office to make a time.

	PEDESTRIAN CROSSING (INCLUDING CHILDREN'S CROSSING)   You must stop within 20 metres before or 10 metres after a   Pedestrian Crossing.   Why is it there? To ensure children can be clearly seen by vehicles   approaching the crossing.	<b>Penalty \$457</b> 2 demerit points

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING (INCLUDING CHILDREN'S CROSSING) You must stop within 20 metres before or 10 metres after a Pedestrian Crossing. Why is it there? To ensure children can be clearly seen by vehicles approaching the crossing.	<b>Penalty \$457</b> 2 demerit points
DOUBLE PARKINGYou must not stop your vehicle or park in the middle of the road to drop off and pick up.Why is it there? Double parking forces cars to go around you causing traffic congestion and reduces the view of drivers and children crossing the road.	<b>Penalty \$344</b> 2 demerit points
<b>Mobile Phone Use</b> Do not use a hand held mobile phone while driving	<b>Penalty \$457</b> 5 demerit points
